

How to size your TWCO bracelet.



This instruction shows how easy it is to size the TWCO bracelet to your wrist.

For optimal comfort and for aesthetic purposes, each side of the bracelet should have the same number of links.

If you choose to remove an uneven number of links, the upper portion of the watchband (on the 12 o'clock side) should be longer.

1. You need the two screwdrivers to adjust the bracelet.
2. Use the screwdrivers like in picture 1 and follow the arrow to loosen the screw (counterclockwise). Repeat this for the other screw.
3. After you unscrewed you will get 2 sets of a small screw and a long pin (see picture 2), and a separate link.
4. Now you can place or remove links. Before placing the small screw back in the pin it is recommended to use a little bit of Loctite 243 thread locker (too tighten the screws: turn clockwise). Put all the loose parts you don't need back in a safe place, like your orange TWCO explorer case.
5. Fine adjustment: use the holes in the clasp (they are on both sides, see arrow in picture 4). To adjust it you can use the spring bar tool (picture 3), you can change the fork to the pin by unscrewing the head (see picture 3).
